President's Message



Greetings friends of NHABDA:

I paid them a visit again tonight for another shower and to wash dishes. Thank you so much dear friends! I hope that all of you survive this calamity safely and we can hopefully share a laugh or two of our experiences at the next dance.

Well enough of our saga and back to NHABDA. The Outreach group had a wonderful time at the Ridgewood Center on Sunday, February 7th. (I was away on a "mini" girls weekend.) Joe did attend it and said that some residents were dancing in the back. 40+ residents were so happy that we performed for them and want us to return.




