As some of you may now already be aware, **Adrienne Haslet**, an Instructor at the Arthur Murray Dance Studio Boston, and her husband Captain Adam Davis USAF, were at the finish line of the Boston Marathon on Patriot's Day. Adrienne was celebrating a day off with her husband, recently back from Afghanistan.

Boston Herald journalist Peter Gelzini reports in the April 22nd edition of the paper, both of young Adrienne and Adam's current conditions, and of her indomitable will to return to the life she knew and loved before the amputation:

"Dancing was something that always made Adrienne Haslet-Davis feel alive. "Like I'm floating," she said yesterday. "When I'm dancing, I don't feel the need to be doing anything else. My joy is complete."

"...I realized you have to be selfish about the things that matter the most. My husband. The job I love. Dancing is my life. Yeah, having my foot blown off, that really sucks. But I can't wallow in woe is me. I can't let some (expletive) come along and steal my whole life. So, I'll dance again. And next year, though I've never been a runner, yes, I plan to run the marathon."

I have had the pleasure of dancing with Adrienne at several Arthur Murray Boston events. Please allow me to reiterate the message of how you can help Adrienne achieve her new goal. A message was shared with us at the April 20th NAHBDA dance
